Letter from the Executive Director

Greetings, Riders!

I am a relative newcomer to the cycling scene in the Yampa Valley. Ten years ago, the only bike I owned was a cruiser that I'd ride from a rental house in Brooklyn to my various restaurant jobs downtown, opting for the bike to avoid a DUI when one "shifter" (no pun intended) drink could easily turn into several. These days I tend to get on my mountain bike 3-4 times a week, or more if I can count any of them as a meeting on my timecard. But I still feel like a bit of a newb, for good reason. The cycling advocacy game in this town has been going strong since the 1980's, a fact of which Pete Wither recently reminded me over pints of Passionate Pedal at Mountain Tap. His eyes shone as he talked about the wildness of the early days of the mountain biking movement here in town - tall tales involving old-school cowboys with a grazing lease on the backside of Emerald, who absolutely despised the growing affinity for taking a road bike up on Emerald and Mt. Werner game trails. They would use chainsaws to drop trees over the game trails getting used by cyclists to try and dissuade these rogue riders from leaving the valley floor.

RCR came to be around this time, almost exactly thirty years ago, from the growing conversations over a plate of orange chicken at the old Panda Garden. It was 1991, and there was a good amount of city and county support for Emerald land swaps - and a dedicated crew of land use advocates who would champion the movement: Wither, Sehler, Beall, Loomis, and many more. Steamboat Resort caught on to the summer usage trends and started putting in multi-use trails for that purpose - Creekside, Zig Zag, the Sunshine Loop. RCR was born at this time as a club for cyclists, to create a sense of community and make an impact on the lives of future riders.

Thirty years later, we want to keep that momentum going in a very similar direction. With all of the growth that Steamboat is experiencing, for better or worse, we are here in the hopes that people of every background will have access to a bike and safe riding areas (roads, trails) that are well-maintained and stewarded. We are here to give bikes the merit they deserve in urban planning and development when it comes to greener transportation. And we are here for our growing community. We'd be remiss if we didn't mention that 2021 was a record-breaking year for RCR memberships and fundraising - THANK YOU for helping us move our mission forward and giving us a chance to grow.

I've been with RCR for nearly three years at this point, and it's transformed my life. It has made me a better communicator, a more staunch advocate for public land access, and without a doubt, a better rider. I can't wait to see what's in store for RCR over the next thirty years. If we are making strides towards providing and nurturing transformative outdoor experiences, we are on the right path.

Letter from the Board President

Well... 2021 was interesting. The world tried to get back to normal, and it snowed a lot in February. Spring fat biking was epic and seemingly lasted forever. Once the trails opened up for the summer, it stayed pretty dry (except when we worked on Soda Mountain and got chased out by heavy rain). With our awesome crew of volunteers, we worked on trails from Oak Creek all the way to Craig. We've been focused on building trust with our local land managers. We helped to give NPR an amazing facelift, reshaping berms and jumps (as fiscal partners and volunteers). Then it rained right away and set it up really nicely. On BTR, we opened up the corners and took out some pedal catchers, with a bit of rain after to seal it down.

Our Bike Match program was not only born, but had instant success, and will have its own temporary home base in the spring, thanks to generous partners. Our road/gravel bike department got the porta-potties back out on popular pedal routes and added another mile to our Adopt-a-Highway commitment. When the rain stopped and the smoke rolled in from various parts of the west, the Emerald Mountain Epic was still a great success. The energy from the volunteers and racers was infectious. It was an amazing summer for bikes.

This winter has been somewhat disappointing for skiing so far, but the fat biking is off the charts. Get out there and pedal, as the Emerald trails groomed by Frank (and many other trails in the county) are as good as it gets. Some packed trails are even rideable with a regular bike.

This spring will bring the final public comment period for the Mad Rabbit Trail Proposal. Please take the time to submit a comment for this new zone of trails that will add many connectors and upgrades to existing trails. Look to RCR for facts about the trails and the process. RCR helped birth this project and the Forest Service (through the NEPA process) has taken it to the next level. The stoke is high!

Now... my time as Board President has come to an end. RCR has changed quite a bit in five years. Our board is passionate, energetic and cohesive. Our programs, new and old, are strongly supported by our community. Our membership base has more than doubled, and through a strategic planning process, RCR has created a plan going into the future. I've eased down to the Vice Presidential role and Craig Frithsen is now the Board President. I am absolutely confident that Craig will continue on the path RCR has been traveling.

2021 Season Highlights



After listening to the needs of the community and a growing desire to see more bike-related projects that increase access and advocate for mobility-based social justice, we launched a new **Bike Match program** to collect donated, used bikes and components and “match” them with community members in need. See a full pilot program rundown on Page 7 of this report!

In May and June of 2021, RCR served as fiscal partner and volunteer supplier for the **privately-funded NPR rebuild project on Emerald Mountain**. Over the span of about a month, a contracted Conservation Trails crew operated heavy equipment to move truckloads of imported dirt and reconstruct built features along the trail. RCR volunteer crews and City of Steamboat Parks + Recreation staff contributed many additional hours to the project. Due to prolonged drought conditions and heavy usage, the built-dirt features on this popular trail need periodic maintenance to be kept to standard. Many thanks to the private donor, along with all of the volunteers, staff, contractors and supporters who made this project happen.



On August 7th and 8th, despite the last-minute encroachment of thick wildfire smoke from afar, RCR co-produced the **first ever in-person Emerald Mountain Epic mountain bike and trail running race** under its new name (after having transitioned to virtual-only format in 2020). Alongside our event co-owners, Partners in Routt County, and Race Director Eli Campbell, we brought back the popular community event with a sold-out racer field of over 1,000 athletes throughout the weekend. While the Air Quality Index created a logistical challenge for refunds and deferrals, the majority of racers felt comfortable participating, and provided (overall) positive feedback.

The support that RCR receives in the community has been growing - and one key way we measure this is through the size of our membership base. **During our Fall 2021 Membership Drive (in partnership with IMBA) we hit 510 members. This is the largest membership base RCR has ever had since it became an IMBA Local Chapter in November 2012** and started tracking memberships. We also had a record year for overall fundraising. We are so grateful for the continued support!



2021 Overall Season Accomplishments



15 volunteer trail work days completed:

Projects with the City of Steamboat Springs, U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, Oak Creek Mountain Park, and CDOT Adopt-a-Highway contributed:

- 195 volunteers on projects
- 788 person-hours at work
- 18 miles of trail maintained and corridor cleared
- 11 signs installed or repaired
- 17 bags of roadside trash cleaned up
- 7 switchbacks and rock ramps built/improved
- 46 feet of retaining wall constructed
- 88 downed or dangerous trees cut from the trail corridor
- 10 feet of fence constructed
- 1 truckload of invasive weeds removed
- Estimated **\$22,500 value** contributed to the community

Second season of RCR Trail Ambassador program:

- **45 volunteer ambassadors** in uniform jerseys throughout the season
- Ambassadors performing education and outreach in popular trail use zones
- Approximately **900 volunteer-hours** in jersey on trails
- Estimated **\$26,000 value** to the community

Along with a host of other programs and projects:

- **6 roadside porta-johns** funded and implemented on popular road riding corridors
- **Installed, monitored and digested data for 26 infrared and magnetic usage counters** all across the local trail network
- **Co-produced and managed the first in-person Emerald Mountain Epic race** under new branding and ownership - over 1,000 athletes participated
- **Published 11 Spoke Talk columns** in the Steamboat Pilot to increase community outreach on various subjects in cycling safety and advocacy
- **Groomed 15 miles of winter singletrack** on Emerald Mountain
- **Advocated for the cyclist's perspective** through active participation and membership in a variety of local, statewide and nationwide committees and groups, including: The Routt Recreation and Conservation Roundtable, 2A Trails Committee, the Oak Creek Mountain Park, Colorado Mountain Bike Coalition, International Mountain Bicycling Association, Routt County Multi-Modal Transportation Advisory Committee, and more

Volunteer Spotlight: Erin Early, RCR Member + Trail Ambassador Extraordinaire



Q: How long have you participated as a Trail Ambassador, and what struck your fancy about it?

A: My friend Liana helped kickstart this program back in 2018(ish) and I wanted to support her, first and foremost. Additionally, I had just ridden that previous summer for a day in Nederland and ran into a Trail Ambassador. We got to chatting, I started to really love the vibe, connection and passion this human shared for trails, because the feeling was mutual. I wanted to do the same thing for our community here in Steamboat. It was pure coincidence that this program was developed soon after that.

Q: Tell us about your ideal (imaginary) day on the trails.

A: It's mid-afternoon/early evening and the temps are starting to cool a bit. I meet up with some of my friends at the trailhead and off we go. I use biking as a way to catch up with my friends so charging uphill is rarely in my repertoire-HA! At the top, we catch a breathtaking sunset, talk about how lucky we are to live where we live, and charge downhill with yips and giggles. Back at the trailhead, we crack open a bevy of choice and make a plan for bigger rides (and to do it all over again).

Q: Tell us what you do to fill the rest of your busy hours outside of “Trail Ambassadoring”.

A: I am the PE teacher at Soda Creek Elementary school. I've been teaching in the Steamboat School District for 14 years and absolutely love it. I also coach for the Steamboat Soccer Club and Steamboat Springs High School. It sure does keep me busy, but it makes my time that I do get on the trails extra special, and I try not to take our local trail systems for granted. Getting out on my bike is my time for fun, connection and reflection.

Q: Why do you volunteer in the community?

A: Giving back is at the core of who I am. When I moved here 14 years ago to be a teacher, I immediately reached out to the Steamboat Soccer Club to see if they needed any coaches, because I knew that as fulfilling as teaching is for me, I still wanted to connect with my community in other ways as well. Coaching was my gateway to other volunteer opportunities such as being a Trail Ambassador.

Q: Why do you choose to support RCR as a member?

A: RCR's vision and mission aligns what I think being a trail steward means. Being a member of an organization that supports social rides, safety, and trail building is just one of the ways I can say thank you for continuing to make my access to our valley trails enjoyable and fun!

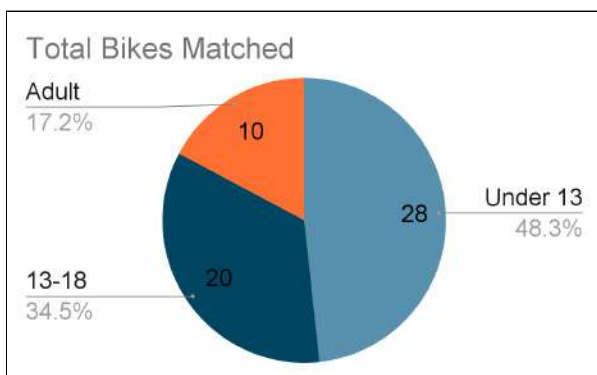

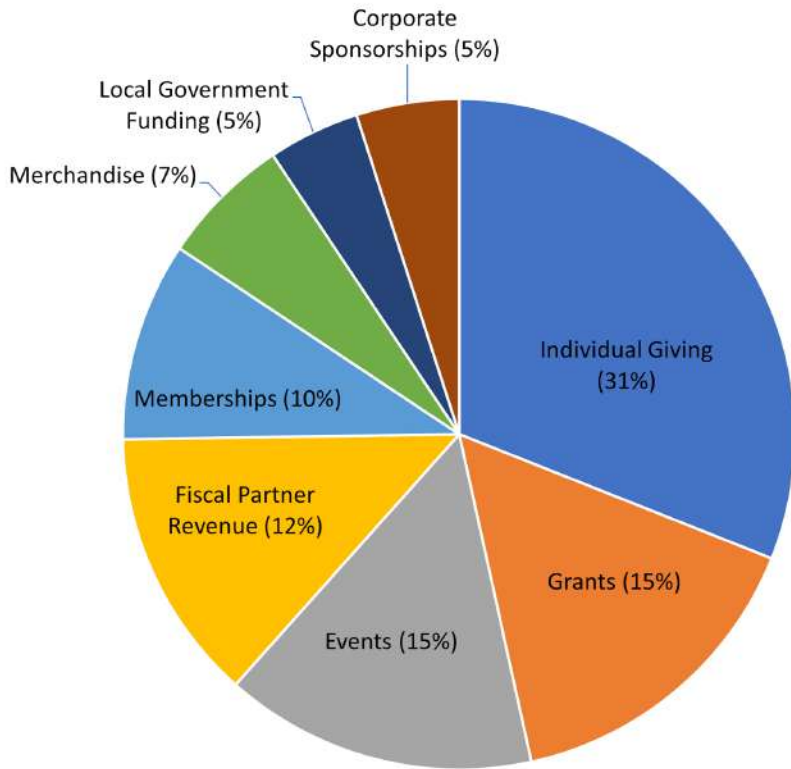

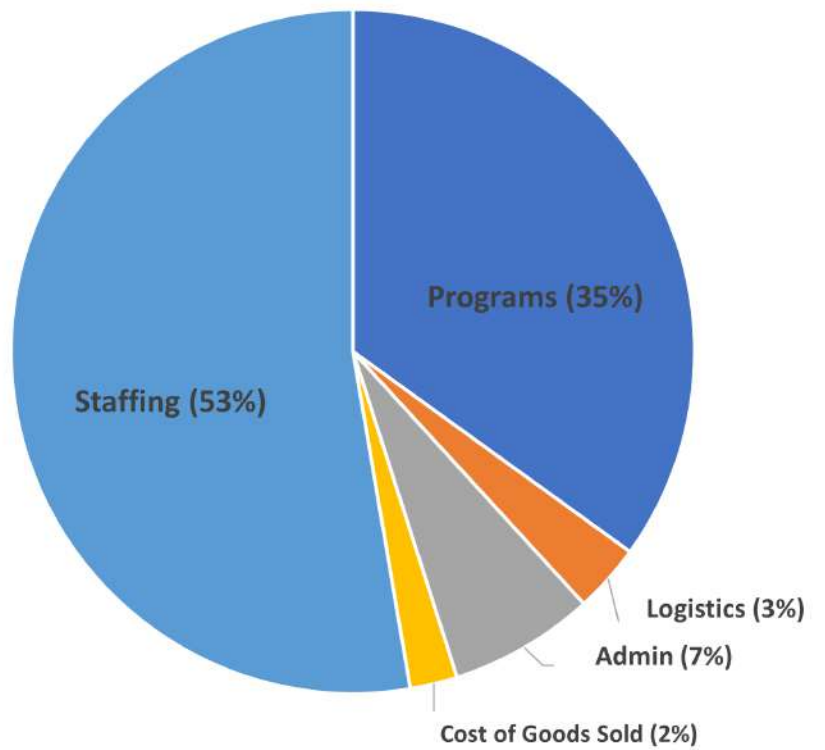
